

HOW TO SCORE CLUB POINTS

AS AT 15/09/2016 FOR THE MOOLOOLABA GAME FISHING CLUB INC.

1. Financial members only can score points.
2. Whether a fish is tagged or captured a Capture Form, Activity Sheet and/or Tag Card correctly filled out and handed or posted to the Club Captain is the only valid way of scoring points.
3. Activity Sheets and Tag Cards must be in the Club Captain's possession by the 28th of the following month the fish was tagged or captured to qualify for MGFC/ QGFA annual awards.
4. All record claim fish in the Game section must remain whole; any fish that is mutilated in any way must have an explanation in writing for the Club Captain to determine if the capture is legal. (Refer to GFAA Gamefish journal on record claims).
5. GFAA angling and equipment rules apply to all times.
6. Heavy tackle is able to be used in any water deeper than 150mtrs. Any line class in this zone less than 15kg for tagging will score as 15kg points. No heavy tackle in waters under 150mtrs depth.
7. Light tackle is able to be used in any water depth.
8. Fish may be captured and weighed on any IGFA line class, however to score club points the fish must weigh the same or exceed the line class. (e.g. a fish caught on 6kg line must weigh 6kg or better). Applies to Game section only.
9. Club fishing boundaries are between Double Island Point (north) to Pt Lookout (south). All points scored outside of these boundaries go to members Out of Area Trophy only. No boat points will accrue for out of area points.
10. Club rally days will be at the discretion of the Committee.
11. For annual Club Champion Overall trophy, the member who wins must have scored points in all sections including Game, Beach, Rock, Estuary & Freshwater having the highest total points overall.

14. Boat points are only eligible if the fish are caught by any angler being a member of a Club affiliated with G.F.A.A, Q.G.F.A, or an I.G.F.A. member. These points must also be scored within the MGFC fishing boundaries.
15. Boat points can only accrue on one boat in any given season. Change to another vessel during the season will accrue points to the new vessel only.
16. Formula for all captured fish (Must be line class):
 FISH WEIGHT (KG) x FIGHTING FACTOR x 100 DIVIDED BY LINE CLASS

BEACH, ROCK & ESTUARY and FRESHWATER SECTION

There is no boundary in this section but it is still governed by the current QLD Fisheries regulations. Fish caught offshore do not apply to this section. Fish other than what's in the species section do not apply. Beach, Rock & Estuary and Freshwater capture/release form must be in the Club Captain's possession by the 28th of the following month the fish was captured or released to qualify for MGFC annual awards.

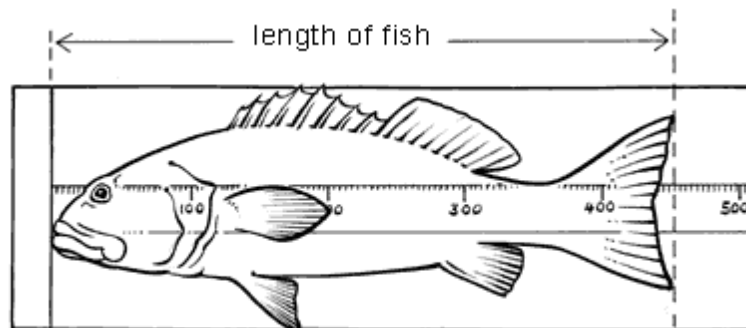
1. Leader... A non-metallic leader of greater breaking strain than the line, but not exceeding one and one half the times (1½) the length of the rod may be used.
2. Double line is permitted provided the leader and double together do not exceed one and one half (1½) times the length of the rod.
3. Lines... Non IGFA rated nylon and braided lines can be used. Breaking strain of line is to be written down on the capture/ release form for points to be calculated. Failure to do this will see no points awarded.
4. Hooks... "J" hooks and Circle hooks can be used with either live or dead bait. Gang hooks are permitted.
5. Dusky Flathead may be weighed for Club points, however there are no records with this species.
6. All fish must be legal length but do not have to exceed line class.
7. Points Formula – Fish Weight in Kilos x Fighting Factor x 100 and divided by Line Class.
8. Fish to be weighed with scales where practicable. If fish are to be released an estimated weight is required.

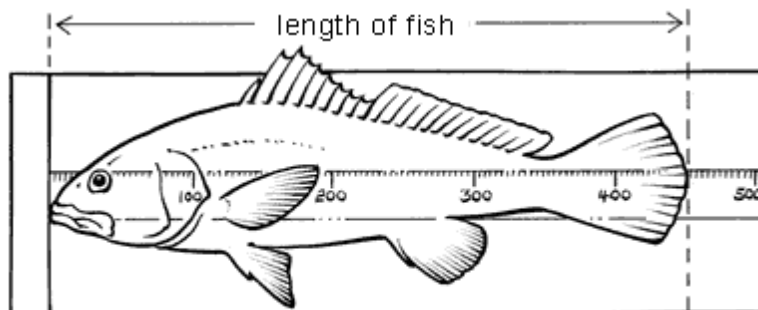

Separate trophies are awarded to Male, Female & Junior/Small Fry

The Robyn Cavill Perpetual Reef Fishing Trophy

Awarded to any angler for the 'heaviest' reef fish of the season

Denise & Brian Black Perpetual First Black Marlin of the Season

Awarded to any angler that tagged the first Black Marlin of the season

Saltwater Charters Perpetual First Sailfish of the Season

Awarded to any angler that tagged the first Sailfish of the season

Out of Area Champion Angler

Awarded to any senior angler that accrued the most points in the Game Fishing category with the Billfish being tagged in Australian waters outside the MGFC Club boundary

Most Improved Angler

Awarded by the Club Captain to any angler who has been the most Improved throughout the season

Janelle Cruice and Allen Harvey Perpetual "Grand Slam" Trophy

Awarded to the first senior angler that recorded a tagged Black Marlin, Sailfish & Yellowfin Tuna in a single day

Champion Heavy Tackle Angler

Awarded to the senior angler who has accrued the most heavy tackle points within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Runner up Heavy Tackle Angler

Awarded to the senior angler who has accrued the second most heavy tackle points within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Champion Boat Heavy Tackle

Awarded to the MGFC boat that has accrued the most heavy tackle points within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Champion Boat Runner Up Heavy Tackle

Awarded to the MGFC boat that has accrued the second most heavy tackle points within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Jeff & Claire Ryan Perpetual Trophy

Awarded to the MGFC boat that records the highest number of tagged Billfish in any single day of the season within the MGFC Club boundaries

Smith Family Trophy

Awarded to the MGFC boat that records the highest daily average points within the MGFC Club boundaries

The Presidents Trophy

Awarded to any financial member for outstanding service to the club (decided by the President)

Champion Boat Under 7 Meters

Awarded to the MGFC boat under 7 meters that accrues the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries

Runner Up Champion Boat Under 7 Meters

Awarded to the MGFC boat under 7 meters that accrues the second most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries

MGFC Perpetual Champion Boat Over 7 Meters

Awarded to the MGFC boat over 7 meters that accrues the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries

Runner Up Champion Boat Over 7 Meters

Awarded to the MGFC boat over 7 meters that accrues the second most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries

Champion Tournament Boat

Awarded to any size MGFC boat that recorded the most tournament points in any QGFA or GFAA sanctioned tournament throughout the season

Runner Up Champion Tournament Boat

Awarded to any size MGFC boat that recorded the second most tournament points in any QGFA or GFAA sanctioned tournament throughout the season

Champion Tournament Angler

Awarded to any senior angler that accrued the most tournament points in any QGFA or GFAA sanctioned tournaments throughout the season

Runner Up Champion Tournament Angler

Awarded to any senior angler that accrued the second most tournament points in any QGFA or GFAA sanctioned tournaments throughout the season

Wayne & Sue Douglass Perpetual Trophy

Awarded to any senior angler that accrued the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC club boundaries & out of area

MYC Fishing Perpetual Club Champion

Awarded to any senior angler that accrued the most points in total in Game, Beach, Rock, Estuary & Freshwater categories

MGFC Perpetual Game Fishing Champion - Female

Awarded to the senior female angler that has accrued the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

MGFC Perpetual Game Fishing Champion - Male

Awarded to the senior male angler that has accrued the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Steve & Debbie Dahl Perpetual Game Fishing Champion

Awarded to any junior or small fry angler that accrued the most points in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC club boundaries throughout the season

Club Captain's Perpetual - Most Shit Fish for the Season

Awarded to any angler that accrued the most points for species other than billfish in the Game Fishing category within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season

Geoff & Pauline Harris Perpetual Rally Day Champion

Awarded to any angler that recorded the most accrued points in the Game Fishing category fishing on nominated MGFC Rally Days within the MGFC Club boundaries throughout the season
