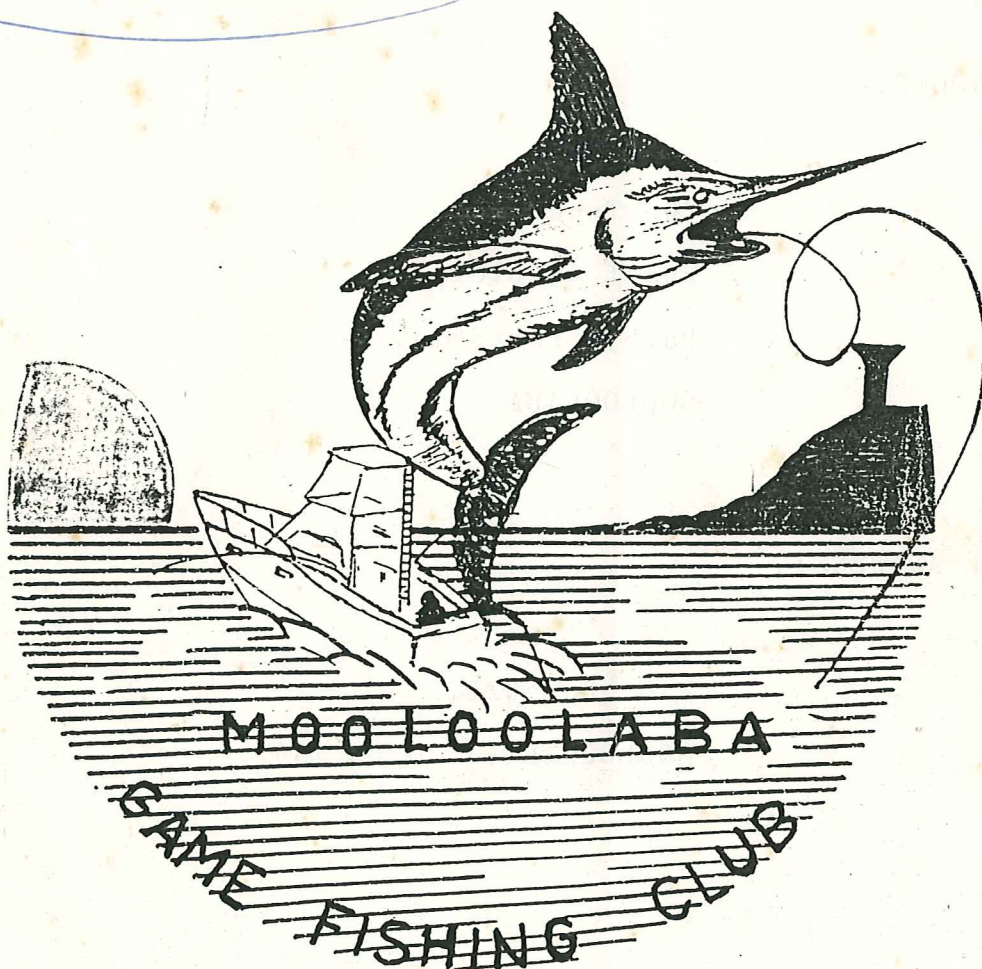

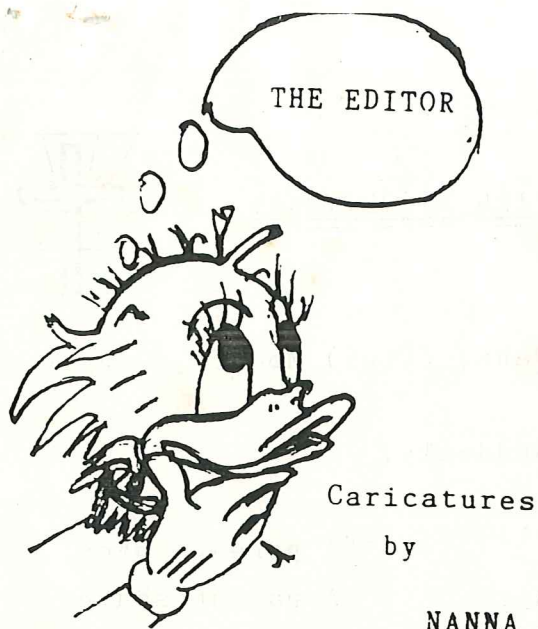

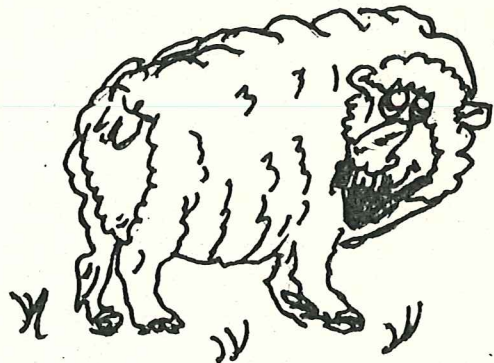

We are going to Goondiwindi for the annual Lions' Fishing Competition on the McIntyre River.

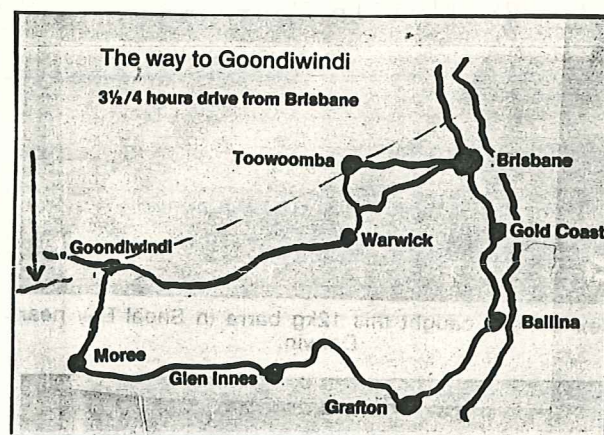


This is a camping weekend for all the family so bring your partner and children so everybody can join in.

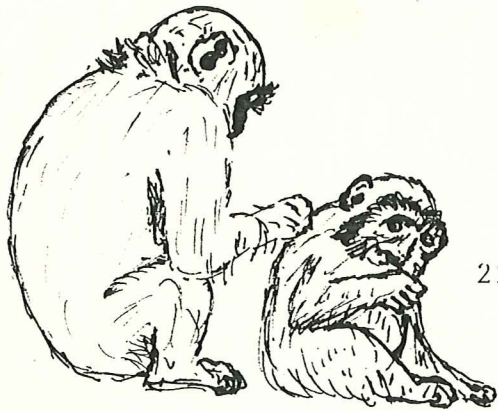

Virgo people have a power-stricken nervous personality and have the ability to manipulate any fishing conversation directly about their own adventures whether interesting or not.

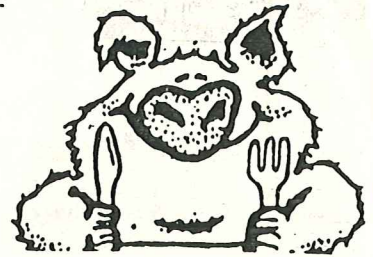
They are hospitable but they are desperate for dominion and will stop at nothing to keep it.
